



GREAT RIVER FILM FESTIVAL – ENTRY RULES

- * Only one submission per filmmaker. Please send us your very best work.
- * All submissions must be postmarked by December 17th, 2010. The Great River Film Festival is not responsible for lost submissions due to inadequate postage or any postal/shipping errors.
- * Only short films (22minutes or shorter) may be submitted. Any film over 22 minutes long, including credits, is not eligible and will be disqualified.
- * All films must have been completed after Jan 1st 2006 and works in progress are NOT eligible.
- * Any entries not in English must contain English subtitles.
- * If your submission was produced as part of a class while you were a student, please indicate “student film” on the DVD and submission form and include a copy of your student ID.
- * To encourage a diverse group of films that will bring entirely new perspectives to the community, we will not be accepting any submissions from current or former Denison University students for this year’s festival.
- * You must submit 1 copy of your film on NTSC DVD (region 1 or 0) for the selection process.
- * All submissions must be in NTSC format and must be clearly marked with your name, film title, running time, genre, contact phone # and email address. Do NOT apply paper labels directly to your DVD.
- * All submissions must be in an amaray DVD case (no paper sleeves or clamshell cases) with the title of the film and your name clearly printed on the spine.
- * If selected for screening, we require an H.264 encoded file for exhibition. If the filmmaker cannot supply a suitable file the festival staff may, at their discretion, create a single digital copy from the submission DVD and encode it for exhibition during the festival.
- * It is your responsibility to ensure that all rights to your submission are cleared for festival screening. The festival will not be held liable for any issues or lawsuits regarding any films that are entered into the festival. Additionally, you must sign the accompanying form verifying that you personally own, or have obtained the rights for the submitted work.
- * The Great River Film Festival retains the right to accept or decline any submission for any reason and it is against our policy to provide any comments, feedback or reasons for decisions made in the selection process.
- * There is NO submission fee required.
- * The festival will keep all DVD copies and promotional material. DVDs will NOT be returned.
- * Filmmakers will be notified of acceptance by February 27th, 2011
